

SYLLABUS FOR BAHAMAS CHECK OUT

Der Bahamas Check Out besteht aus

- Theorieunterricht (Lesson 1)
- Trainingsflug (Lesson 2)

Der Trainingsflug findet in der Umgebung des Flugplatzes St. Augustine, zum Teil über offenem Wasser statt. D.h. Sie müssen nicht mit einem Fluglehrer auf die Bahamas fliegen. Nachfolgend finden Sie das Einweisungsprogramm in englischer Sprache. Je nach individueller Erfahrung kann das Programm etwas abweichen.

Lesson 1: Ground School- As required including at least:

1. Flight to the Bahamas from selected airports in Florida and Airport of Entry (AOE) in Bahamas.
2. Obtaining weather briefing in USA and Bahamas (1-800- 992-7433) works also in the Bahamas.
3. Filing flight plans in the USA and the Bahamas; USA and Bahamas airspace recognition..
4. Safety requirements as per FAR`s: Fuel, life jackets and other suggested equipment (life raft, tie downs, extra oil).
5. VFR must be on ground in Bahamas from sunset to sunrise.
6. Verify NAVAID availability in the Bahamas and obtaining necessary airport information.
7. Mandatory equipment: Original registration and airworthiness, pilot license and medical, life vest for each person, ID (passport, birth certificate, no drivers license).
8. Verify fuel-availability at destination.

Lesson 2: Flight as required including at least

1. Simulated instrument flight: straight-and level, turns, climbs-and descents, and unusual attitudes.
2. Visual over-water flying {ex: 090° heading from SGJ remaining within gliding distance.
3. Identifying VOR and/or ADF, radial bearing intercept and tracking.
4. Demonstrate short field takeoff and landing.
5. Demonstrate crosswind takeoff and landings..
